What are the nine priorities the Navajo Nation?

Lorena indicated that the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative Branches of the Navajo Nation met and developed a priorities list that all can work toward. The Farming and Ranching is listed at the 9^{th} priority list. She does have a copy but not at the moment.

The farm board conducted survey to figure out why farmers don't farm. A large percentage, indicated that they have no equipment. As a result, the Farm Board submitted a \$2.9 million proposal to request for farm equipment and man power.

II. OLD BUSINESS

a. Fish and Wildlife - Prairie Dog Control

Lorena explained that at the last meeting, the farmers have been concern about the prairie dog. Due to the growing population, the farmers are unable to plant. As a result, we decided to request Navajo Nation Fish and Wildlife staff to present information on the latest effective treatment today at 10am. However, they are not present today. They might be very busy with Shiprock area.

Action: Write a letter to Navajo Fish and Wildlife to request for presentation from them at next meeting.

b. Alternative Plan -

Lorena explained that within Tsaile – Wheatfields Chapter there are 127 farmers who utilizes irrigation water to farm their land. However, there are many idling farmlands in all three areas. Three years ago when the Farm Board came into office they established a goal. The goal statement, "By summer 2015, 100% of the farmland will be a productive farmland." The Farm Board conducted surveys to figure out why people have idling farmland, and many indicated it was to lack of equipment. This alternative plan has been in the works for several years. Several farmers were selected to be a part of the project and three criteria was used, Soil health; probate cases; or idling land for 30 years or more.

Dorthea comment that she has not written to the selected farmer, but she will do that.

Action: Write and submit letter to identified farmers to let them know that the Farm Board is requesting for their participations in the project. Ask the identified farmer to attend next Farm Board meeting on Friday, September 18, 2015. This already put to motion at last meeting on August 9, 2015.

Lorena explained that the Tsaile – Wheatfields Chapter is hosting the Regional Water Plan meeting on Wednesday, September 2, 2015 at 9am Wheatfields Chapter House.

Adele indicated that she is aware of and is involve with so many? She suggested to have Robin do a presentation to the people.

Robin reported that she attended a Resource Development Committee Meeting. The members of RDC are developing an Integrated Resource Plan, and plan to go public with it at a later date. The plan outlines:

- 1. Restart timber cutting for commercial use
- 2. Sand Gravel Operation
- 3. Gas and Oil drilling

The concerns are to DO MORE resource extraction, and NO PLAN for RESTORATION or other sustainable solution.

Dorthea suggested to have a one day workshop for people to attend. The presenters of the workshop need to develop scenarios for situation in order for attendees to really understand.

Action: To have Robin Jackson to do a presentation on Very Concern Issues that the Navajo Nation will be challenge with in near future - Water Rights Issue; the impact the Integrated Resource Plan that the Navajo Nation is developing.
