II. OLD BUSINESS

a. Proposal

Lorena explained to the people that the Farm Board and Water Users are in the process of writing a proposal requesting for equipment and personnel to implement farm projects and increase water development. The requested amount is about \$2.5 million. The organizations have identified priorities in the following:

- 1. Equipment and personnel
- 2. Warehouse
- 3. Improve Irrigation canals and diversion dams for Upper Wheatfields and Tsaile Farmland area.
- 4. Tsaile water plan
- 5. Fence Boundaries for all three farmland area

Tsaile – Wheatfields Farm Board & Water Users Joint Meeting Sunday, November 30, 2014 Wheatfields Chapter House, Wheatfields, AZ

She read the data the organizations have for the last three years in terms of the number of percent of idling farmlands, and conducted a survey from 89 farmers to determine, "Why there is a large percent of Idling Farmland?" The results indicated lack of equipment and finance were the two primary reasons why the farmlands sit idling. All of these creates a problem statement for the proposal, and, at the same time, the goal of the Farm Board is by a 2015 100% of the farmlands will be in production.

Questions, comments, or suggestions:

Freddie Yazzie encouraged the Farm Board and Water Users to continue the process of working on the proposal. He is glad to know that the organizations are working for the farmers and the people as much as they can. He certainly agrees that the outside boundary fence areas for the three farmland area is critically needed due to wildlife eating what the farmers are trying to produce. At the same time, he shared his concerns for the impact the new irrigation system might have for the Tsaile area.

Action: No action taken; it's for information.

b. Community Water Plan

Lorena explained that Dorthea requested 50,000 from the Tsaile – Wheatfields chapter to secure money to conduct a water plan study for the community. This community water plan is a continuous work effort to be made by the Farm Board, Water Users Board, Chapter Officials, and Community Land Use Committee members.

Dorthea explained there is no request of land-use permit transfers relinquishment or probate. However, the people at the meeting had questions on conservation plans. For example Rosita Benally explained that she needs soil map information about their farmland plus she was told the Farm Board has information about soil testing was conducted for Lower Wheatfields. In addition, the current farmland is all open with Noel and Rudy's farmland, and they are unsure where the mark should be placed to know the acreage of their farmland.

Dorthea explained she copies of the soil map, and they were presented a copy of the soil testing results conducted for Lower Wheatfields.

Lorena requested Rosita to make BIA staff to resurvey the farmland to identify the acreage for the farmland.

b. Financial Report – Water Users

Dorthea reported the beginning balance for the Water User accounts: \$30,353.94, and she deposit \$201 and the expenditure is about at Sam's Club to purchase food for the November 12, 2014 Water Users meeting. By the end of November the balance should be \$30,554.94. Please note: This is an estimate she's has not cross-reference all of these in the Water Users' account accounting system on the computer.

Within the Navajo Nation, there are about four committees that the Navajo Nation Council Delegates have, and budget and finance is a committee that is composed of six Council delegates. Dorthea presented three different PowerPoint presentations that were conducted by the organizations in the past. Based on what was presented, there was a request that pictures and maps of the location needs to be added.

Action: Dorthea is to put two PowerPoint presentations together to make it as one. The PowerPoint that presents the success of Lower Wheatfields Irrigation project and the April 2014 workshop are to merge as one, and be presented to the Navajo Nation Budget and Finance Committee.
