Lorena explained that BIA has the absolute authority to approve the Land Use Permit issues; Resource and Development Committee are planning to consolidate the Farm Board member: and Tsaile – Wheatfeilds planned a Revitalization Plan – to date only have two people who are interested.

Lorena stated, How do we overcome the high number of idling farmland we have? We had suggested to move this to the next Navajo Nation Joint Farm Board Meeting in March 17, 2016. Maybe the can give a directive of how it can be overcome.

Lucinda suggested to have a written resolution to the officers of the Reservation Wide farm board members.

Lorena commented, "We have presented to Resource & Development Committee, but they told us to have outside Corporation take over the idling farmland."

Kathy suggested to inform the people the about the future plan that the Nation is talking about. She does not appreciate what the RDC members had to say.

Aaron commented that politicians are can be very cruel people. Often they make decision NOT in the BEST interest of what is RIGHT for their people. "If the Council Delegate who sit on Resources and Development Committee are say to give all the idling farmlands to outside Corporation might be something they are really looking to do. It is so Hard to Tell?" The outside Corporations might be giving them offers to make this type of comment. For example, Senator John McCain and Jeff Flake were influence by outside Mining Corporations from oversea to open a Mining on the Apache Reservation in Payson, AZ, and they created legislation without letting the Tribes know. The same is going on with the Utah Water Rights. Our Council Delegates never involve the people who will be effected by this legislation. He does not think the Navajo Nation Resource and Development Committee will not share a directive on dealing with Probate Cases or any Idling Farm Land.

Lorena commented that the Navajo Nation Farm Board have policies and procedures to follow and recommend that, but we are not sure if it will be supported. We have been asking for support and that has NOT happen to date.

Action: To write a resolution to Navajo Nation Joint Farm Board member to request to take up this concern. Motioned by Kathy Johns Seconded by Aaron Begay Voting: 5 yes; 0 no; 1 abstained
