Only 2 persons are working at Chinle BIA Natural Resource Office The BIA office is working on improving Graze and Land Use Permit All Grazing Permit and Land Use that were transfer is on hold due to the delay on NEPA (Nation Environmental Policy Act) Dealing with lack of rain and drought issue

In addition, the Navajo Nation Council who are members of the Resources and Development Committee are requesting the Farm Board to use Beneficial Use.

At the Farm Board of Tsaile & Wheatfields Chapter has been working very hard in reaching their goal, and trying to education their farmers and people about the food sovereignty. They submitted to a proposal for 2.9 million dollars to request for farm equipment and personal staff.

She further explain the function of Navajo Nation Government to help the people understand who the Navajo Resource and Development Committee members were.

Dorthea presented the power point presentation that the Farm Board and Water User presented to the Navajo Nation Budget and Finance Committee a year ago.

Questions, comments, and suggestions:

Freddie Yazzie: Prairie Dogs, goffers, and deer are a huge problem to farming.

Lorena: She explained the Revitalization of Farm Land Project to the people. However, the major purpose of the presenting to Navajo Nation Resources and Development Committee is to request for their support of implementing the Revitalization of Farm land Project or will they request for us to move with implementing the actual law spelled out Title 3.

For example, Art Allen agree the project, and his farm land is a little over 12 acres. His definitely falls under the category of what are spelled out in the Revitalization Project. For Angela Kedelty, she subleased the farmland to us, and stated that she will not be able to help due to her health issue, and all her children live off the Navajo reservation and they are unable to help. The late Louise Begay farmland is at 2 acres in Lower Wheatfield is very different again. Beyond this we need to figure out what are we (Farm Board) to do with the farmland that are sublease to us. We need to know the condition of the land and fencing of the land.
