As Farm Board members were able to visit Angela Kedelty's Farmland; from there Lorena and Lucinda visited the late Louise Begay's farmland in Lower Wheatfields, and Aaron and Dorthea visited Arthur Allen's farmland. The following are the assessments:

NRCS staff, Mr. Richard Begay, reported that last year, million dollars had to be returned to the government due to lack of proposal that the Navajo Nation submitted.

Stipend are being cut for the Farm Board to \$108.00 per meeting. However, going forward from here the Farm Board has requested Mr. Otto Tso, Council Delegate to sponsor a legislation during the Winter Session to have the Council Delegate to at least request to see if Farm Board can receive stipend for attending Chapter meeting. Current request to have it at \$500 per month for attending Chapter Meeting.
